The Foundation team is led by Pina Di Donato, Executive Director, Public Affairs and Foundation, and Melissa Grenville, Foundation Director. Melissa leads a small group of enthusiastic individuals who are passionate about making a difference with her team, consisting of Margaret Rivette, Fundraising Campaigns Officer, Tatjana Dimoska, Administration and Database Officer and Kim Berger, Community Engagement Coordinator. They work closely with Henni Wade, Volunteer Services Manager, who is a fantastic support to the team.

Over the 2022-23 period, they funded more than \$800,000 in medical equipment and research across all four Northern Health campuses, including state-of-the-art medical equipment and technology to enhance patient care, supporting the upgrade of patient and visitor facilities and funding Ph.D. scholarships to support ground-breaking medical research.

While there is fantastic support from government funding, there are many areas within the health service where staff and departments identify a need and come to the team for assistance.

The Foundation works towards fulfilling those needs with the available resources to build on the services and become an even stronger support system for staff and the community.

Northern Health staff are also wonderful contributors through the Workplace Giving Program. Pre-tax contributions are

dollar-matched by BankVic up to \$20,000 and are used to fund projects around our health service. Most recently, Workplace Giving contributions have enabled the purchase of beautiful art pieces in the Palliative Care Unit at Northern Hospital Epping.

Melissa Grenville, Director Foundation, says, "We're a small team who do amazing work, tirelessly fundraising to support our staff and health service. As the new Director, I am excited to work with the board, executives, Pina and the Foundation team to implement our strategic plan and grow our team to be fully resourced. IN LOVING MEMORY OF **ADA MARTIN**

Ada Martin was known as a strong, active, independent woman who was still driving her car and going on many bus tours prior to her passing. She kept her house spotless, mowed the lawn and maintained her vast and beautiful gardens. She also enjoyed many activities; especially live theatre shows and movies.

After surviving bowel cancer, Ada was unfortunately diagnosed with lung cancer in early 2022. She was admitted to Northern Hospital after suffering falls and blackouts where she was later diagnosed with head cancer. From there, she was transferred to rehabilitation until her illness progressed and required more care.

Ada was admitted to Ian Brand Residential Care at Bundoora Centre on 17 January, 2023. Her daughter, Linda, reflected on Ada being very happy there, with the fantastic staff involving her in the many daily activities. Just like at home, Ada loved watching movies and spent time doing so with the other patients.

"She was well cared for, and we are grateful for the loving treatment she was given as Ada was quite dependent on the staff for everything," mentions Linda.

"The Bundoora gardens are so peaceful and beautiful, especially with the bird activity. They are well-maintained, and there are many places to just sit and enjoy."

With Ada's passing, her family wanted to do something special in memory of Ada and her love of gardens and

nature. In honour of the caring staff, a donation was

made to enhance the gardens at Bundoora Centre, with many plants in flower. It will only improve as they mature.

"We are truly thankful for the wonderful job the staff did and hope that the many residents and visitors enjoy the garden as much as we did," said Linda.

Ada was at Ian Brand Residential Care for four months. The family will be forever grateful to staff for making her last days bearable.
